

QUALIFICATION COURSE OF FIRE

**Fifty (50) round New York State DCJS qualification course of fire.
A passing score of 70 percent with factory ammunition is required.**

- 3 yard line – 12 rounds fired in two phases:
Phase # 1 – 6 rounds fired in two round increments – no time limit
Phase # 2 – 6 rounds fired in 6 seconds
- 7 yard line – 18 rounds fired in two phases:
Phase # 1 – 6 rounds fired in two round increments – no time limit
Phase # 1 – 12 rounds fired in 25 seconds with one reload
- 15 yard line – 12 rounds fired in 40 seconds with one reload
- 25 yard line – 8 rounds fired in 40 seconds with one reload

The above qualification course was designed for 6 shot revolvers.
Five shot revolvers are more difficult to qualify with.

If at all possible use a 6 shot service type revolver.

Reloading devices are suggested but not required.

Semi-automatic shooters are required to have a **minimum of two magazines.**
